As a net-zero emission and climate-responsive measure, it offers farm units encased by the Miyawaki forest. Phase 1 of Woods Shamshabad comprises a three-year-old man-made forest that is already self-sustaining! Building upon the resounding success of Phase 1, Phase 2 will encompass 100+ acres of total project land, offering 150 individual plots sized 1800-3500 sq. yards.

Woods Shamshabad Phase 2 will deploy a fast-growing forestation technique that fosters the rapid development of a thriving native ecosystem. Reiterating the existing 4,50,000 trees and plants, over 150+ native trees and new plants will be cultivated, spawning an expanded, vibrant natural habitat for more than 141 species of birds and 126 native fruiting and flowering trees.

Beyond its stunning aesthetics, Woods Shamshabad is designed to act as a natural filter, cleansing the air and water within the village and surrounding areas. It actively sequesters carbon footprints, promoting energy efficiency and mitigating the impact of climate change. This dedication to sustainability extends to the diverse native plant life, which attracts a variety of pollinators and wildlife, further enriching the local ecosystem.
